A QUICK JOURNEY THROUGH the BIBLE: AN 8-Part Introduction to the BIBLE TIMELINE

The primary goal of this study is to introduce participants to Scripture and to make the Bible approachable by explaining the overarching story and showing how the various books fit together to get the story across. By the end of the 8-part video-based program, participants should be able to:

- * Recall the progression of the story of salvation history by reciting the 12 historic periods**
- * Recognize how God’s plan unfolded through a series of covenants, and understand and explain those covenants**
- * Identify the narrative books of the Bible - the 14 books that, read in order, tell the story from start to finish**
- * Use the Bible Timeline chart and bookmark to place any book of the Bible within the timeline of Bible history**
- * Be prepared to delve deeper into a study of the individual books, and hear the readings at mass with a far greater understanding and appreciation**
