Jan. 23/27	Unit 1, Chap. 5	Students will describe how we can make God's concern for all people visible in the world.
Feb. 10/13 Feb. 24/27	Family Lent event Unit 5, Chap. 5	Student will describe the consequences of lying, calumny, and the sin of detraction.
March 2/5	Unit 2, Chap. 5	Students will Express that belief in Jesus' resurrection is the foundation of our hope.
March 9/12	Unit 2, Chap. 3	Students will relate an understanding of why Jesus died on the cross.
March 30/April 2	Unit 4, Chap. 1/2	Students will explain what happens when we celebrate mass, explain why baptism is necessary for salvation and describe the sacrament of confirmation
April 6/9	Unit 4, Chap. 4/5	Students will describe Penance and anointing of the sick as sacraments of healing and why, along with explaining how marriage and priesthood are vocations people are called to.
April 13/16	Unit 4, chap. 3	Students will identify the Eucharist as the source and summit of all Christian life.
